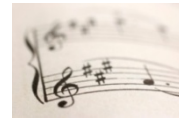




Music 7 Class Rules!



Welcome to Music class! The following rules are for all students in Music 7!

- **Arrive on time!**
 - Make sure you are here before the 2nd bell.
 - Sit in your assigned seat as soon as you enter the room.
 - Clear your desk in preparation for prayer.
- **Be prepared!**
 - Materials for every class – iPad, staff note book, folder, pens and pencils. Having a pencil every class will be essential for the work you will be completing.
 - Don't forget anything in your locker! You will not be allowed to go back to get any forgotten items.
- **Homework**
 - Assignments will be given at the beginning of each period. They will be pushed to you via e-backpack. **REMEMBER: On your e-backpack calendar your assignments will appear on their DUE DATE!**
 - Homework assignments requiring the use of your staff notebook should be completed in the **back of your staff notebook.**
 - Homework **will be checked!** Failure to complete an assignment will result in A.D. on the day the assignment was due. No Excuses!
 - All students start with a 100% Homework Average. Each missed assignment will result in a 5-point deduction from that average. Points may not be made up. Several missed homework assignments may result in a call home.
 - DO YOUR HOMEWORK!
 - Class website – Go to the Kellenberg website (**Kellenberg.org**). Click on **Faculty**. Find my name under **Fine Arts**. Clicking on **Collins, Mr. Emmett** will take you to my website where you will find our class page called **Music 7**. While assignments and other documents will be pushed to you through e-backpack you will also be able to find them here if you have any difficulty.
- **Quizzes**
 - Quizzes are typically announced **one class day** before they are given.
 - Quizzes are given in both scantron and written form
 - Your overall quiz average is added with your homework average to create a combined HW/Quiz average for each trimester.
- **Tests**
 - Tests occur at the end of each unit. They will be announced at least **one week** before the date of the exam.
 - There is typically a full class day dedicated to review before each test.
 - The test average counts as one-third of your total trimester grade.
- **Projects**
 - There will be a group project towards the end of each Trimester.
 - Information will be handed out at least one month before it is due.
- **Extra Help**
 - Extra help is available to any student who does not understand a topic being discussed in class and requires some added assistance.
 - Extra help is offered every day. However, you must see me to tell me you are coming. You can schedule an extra help session after class. I can also be found in my homeroom, Room 139, every morning beginning at 7:50am.
